



2) Existing MATURA partners - Application process to run new research on samples/data within MATURA

Discussion with work steam leads and if data access required then discussion at monthly Biostats TC to ensure no duplication

Data Access – for new project using existing data within MATURA

Data Generation – to request new data generation not already being undertaken

Written proposal, including data required, methods and timeline.

Written proposal including funding, sample types, sample volumes required and plan for returning data

Once approved – submit to PSG1 and/or PSG2 (via email or prior to quarterly meeting, majority approval or minimum quorum of 50% required to vote)

MATURA DSSP – data provided according to access levels agreed as per DSSP

Agreement on new data upload to TranSMART MTA if required

Once approved – circulated to CMB for ratification. Biostats/TranSMART team notified
